Under the general supervision and direction of the Head Coach, the Assistant Coach will assist with all aspects of a NCAA Division II women's basketball program including but not limited to: coaching, recruiting, maintenance of a strong academic environment, compliance with NCAA, conference and institutional regulations. The university seeks an individual who has demonstrated success in attracting campus and community support.

California State University, San Bernardino (a Hispanic serving Institution) is located in San Bernardino in the Inland Empire, 60 miles East from Los Angeles. CSUSB offers programs through the colleges of Arts and Letters, Business and Public Administration, Education, Natural Sciences, Social and Behavioral Sciences and operates a satellite campus in Palm Desert located in Coachella Valley. CSUSB serves approximately 20,700 students and offers 47 undergraduate, 35 graduate and one doctoral degree as well as 13 programs with national accreditation.

Bachelor's degree is required, master's degree preferred, and a minimum of five years successful athletic administration experience, preferably at the collegiate level.
